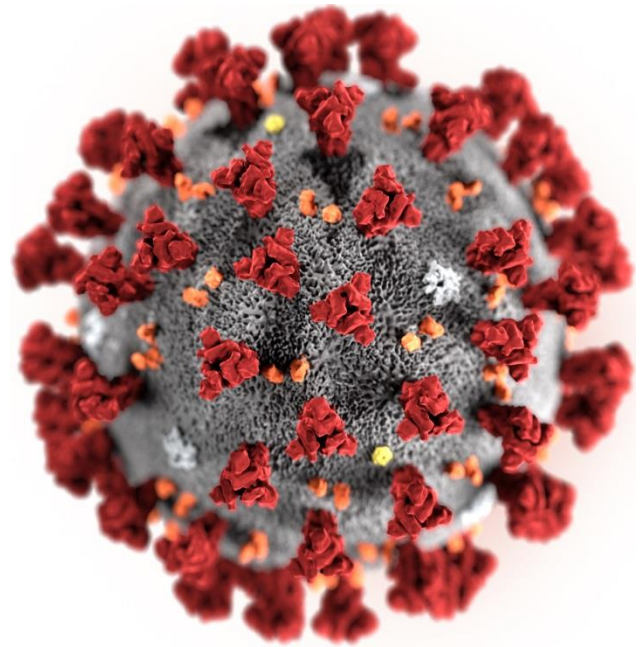

An Update in Uncertain Times

The coronavirus pandemic is having an unprecedented effect on our community, our country, and the world. Many of us are trying to make sense of this crisis and the few answers that are available seem ambiguous and contradictory. Those of us that pride ourselves on planning months and years in advance are relegated to planning on a daily and sometimes hourly basis.

The virus has obviously taken a toll on the skeet calendar and many of us are anxious to see light at the end of the tunnel. As we plan for our State Championships, it is clear that we do not have all of the answers at this time. It is also clear, however, that we are committed to placing the safety and well-being of our shooting community, our families, and the gun club & support staffs, first and foremost in our decision-making process.

There have been many discussions on whether to hold the State Shoot on the originally scheduled dates of June 11th through the 14th. Although we would like to commit to the original dates, there is just too much uncertainty at this time. We have worked with the Greater Houston Sports Club management to discuss potential, alternative dates and we have worked hard to ensure that the state shoot committee has a firm understanding of all of our options. The good news is that we DO have options.



We have elected to defer a final decision on the particulars of the State Championships, until May 1st. We believe that making a decision six-weeks ahead of the currently scheduled date of the shoot will allow everyone adequate time to plan and make any necessary changes to their itineraries. We hope that the next few weeks will yield a much higher level of clarity regarding the progression of the virus and its impact.
